SAN FERNANDO, CA – Please be advised that the San Fernando City Council will be considering a walk-on item at tonight’s regular City Council meeting to declare a local emergency as a result of the COVID-19 outbreak. In addition to discussing actions the City has taken to date, the City Council may also discuss taking further action, including, but not limited to, ordering bars, nightclubs, gyms and other entertainment venues to close for a period of time and limiting dine-in eating at local restaurants.
