

MANDATORY WATER CONSERVATION INFORMATION

In order to try and achieve the State requirement of 25% reduction in water use due to the ongoing drought conditions, the City has activated the mandatory Emergency Water Conservation Plan Ordinance – **Phase II**, <u>effective Wednesday, July 1, 2015</u>. Below are the current water use restrictions. Doing your part to conserve will help the City avoid potential fines by the State.





Outdoor watering with sprinklers is restricted to three days a week with different watering days assigned to odd-numbered and even-numbered street addresses.

- No irrigating between 10:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
- Even number address water on even number days (Tuesday, Thursday, Sunday)
- Odd number address water on odd number days (Monday, Wednesday, Friday)
- No watering on Saturdays
- No gutter flooding
- No washing hard surfaced areas (sweeping is recommended)
- No refilling of pools, fountains, or other ornamental facilities
- Wash vehicles only with a hand-held bucket, a shutoff nozzle, or a commercial car wash
- Repair any leaks immediately
- Restaurants serve water to customers 'by request only'
- Generally, no person shall cause or allow water under his control to be wasted.
