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WHO WE ARE

Law Enforcement Exploring is a worksite-based program for young men and women who have completed the eighth grade and are 14 years of age, or are 15 years of age but have not yet reached their 21st birthday.

Law Enforcement Explorer posts help youth to gain insight into a variety of programs that offer hands-on career activities. For young men and women who are interested in careers in the field of law enforcement, Exploring offers experiential learning with lots of fun-filled, hands-on activities that promote the growth and development of adolescent youth.

The San Fernando Police Explorer Post 521 has been in existence for over forty years and is an active charter unit of Learning for Life. This program is conducted from the San Fernando Police Department and was created to teach youth leadership, responsibility, to provide exposure to those desiring a career in Law Enforcement, and to provide a service to the community.

The following are only a few of the many Explorer activities and services provided.

- Ride-along with Police Officers during patrol
- Assist Desk Officers in the Department's Communication Center
- Child Fingerprinting and minor standardized report writing
- Issue bicycle licenses
- Assist with traffic and crowd control at parades, festivals, and special City events
- Participate in the San Fernando Christmas Basket Program for needy residents and other numerous community events

This program encourages, motivates, and guides youth to strive for academic excellence, and self-betterment through leadership and service to the community.

REQUIREMENTS AND TRAINING

The program is offered to young men and women who have completed the eighth grade and are 14 years of age, or are 15 years of age but have not reached their 21st birthday. If they are students, a minimum grade point average of "C" (2.0) is required on the last report card or graduation from high school or equivalency. All applicants must meet the following conditions an requirements:

- 14 years of age, or are 15 years of age but have not yet reached their 21st birthday
- Minimum grade point average of "C" (2.0)
- Have no record of serious arrests or convictions
- Be free of any physical deficiencies that would jeopardize the explorer or others in the Program
- Present a written recommendation from a teacher, religious leader, or other responsible non-related adult
- Submit a completed Explorer application with a copy of applicant's most recent report card
- Pass an oral interview
- Pass a background investigation
- Obtain a medical examination, prior to entering the Explorer Program
- Write an autobiography
- Maintain good moral character
- Attend and graduate from the Explorer Academy
- Demonstrate a willingness to serve and participate in Explorer activities

After acceptance into the program, initial training for Police Explorer takes place at one of the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Explorer Academies. The Explorer Academy consists of approximately 184 hours of instruction during 18 weeks of training on Saturdays. Subjects such as community relations, criminal law, demeanor, firearms safety, narcotics control, police procedures and weaponless defense must be mastered. The trainees are required to undergo drill and physical training as well as their classroom work.

The program is staffed by Law Enforcement Officials, adult leaders, and seasoned Explorers. The curriculum is taught and developed by the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Training Bureau Commander and Department Curriculum Committee. The courses are designed to teach youths leadership, responsibility, respect, honesty, integrity, and discipline while learning the fundamentals of law enforcement. While in the Academy all cadets must attend a weekly meeting to assist them with their training. At the completion of the Explorer Academy, the recruit graduates and becomes a Police Explorer.
