Location: 120 North Macneil Street, San Fernando, CA 91340 ("Public

**Works Operations Facility"**)

Applicant: T-Mobile West Corporation (c/o Synergy Development Services,

Inc.) 16147 Wyandotte Street, Van Nuys, CA 91406

Proposal: The proposed project entails the construction and use of a

wireless telecommunications facility on the site of a City-owned facility (Public Works Operation Facility) within the C-1 (Limited Commercial) zone and Redevelopment Project Area No. 3. Subject to approval by the Planning and Preservation Commission, an application for a conditional use permit (pursuant to City Code Section 106-1326 and 106-13356(5)) has

been submitted to allow for the facility's installation and operation on a city-owned property used for municipal purposes. The proposed facility includes the construction of a tower structure ("monopole"), with 12 antennas on three sectors, and a ground mounted equipment shelter to house the facility's associated equipment.

**Recommendation:** 

Staff recommends that the Planning and Preservation commission approve the Mitigated Negative Declaration and Initial Study, Conditional Use Permit 2011-04, and Site Plan Review 2011-06, pursuant to Planning and Preservation Commission Resolution 2011-08 and the conditions of approval attached as Exhibit "A" to the resolution ("Attachment 1").

If, in the future, you wish to challenge the items listed above in Court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice or in written correspondence delivered to the City Planning and Preservation Commission at, or prior to, the public hearing. Decisions of Planning and Preservation Commission may be appealed to the City Council within 10 days following the final action.
