SAN FERNANDO POLICE ANNOUNCE **"TORCH RUN" TO BENEFIT SPECIAL OLYMPICS**

San Fernando, CA – On Wednesday, June 5, 2019, the San Fernando Police Department will participate in the Law Enforcement Torch Run for the Special Olympics of Southern California Summer Games. The team of Police Officers and City personnel will run side-by-side with Special Olympic Athletes, Los Angeles School Police, and DMV Investigators to accept the “Flame of Hope” Torch from the Los Angeles Police Department Mission Division Team.

The torch will be carried throughout the City of San Fernando along a 2.6 mile route starting at approximately 9:05 am.

The Flame of Hope symbolizes courage and celebration of diversity that represents the spirit of the Special Olympics and will be used to light the cauldron at the Special Olympics Southern California Summer Games at Cal State University of Long Beach.

The San Fernando Police Department Team will be led by Field Training Officer/Canine Officer Walter Dominguez. “We are extremely excited to be a part of this run for the fourth year in a row! Over the past four years we have seen hundreds of people line the streets when the torch has been run through our city which has inspired us to continue to be a part of this great cause,” said Dominguez.
