In honor of Park & Recreation Month, the Department of Recreation & Community Services is proud to recognize **RCS Coordinator Marisol Diaz** for all her efforts and dedication in keeping the senior community connected during the pandemic. Over the past 15 months, the entire world was forced to change the way we do simple everyday routines like going to the supermarket. Our department was no different. Now imagine overseeing a free lunch program, programming, exercise classes and you would get a glimpse of how Marisol's job drastically changed during the stay at home orders.



Over the past year, Marisol has been the lead in not only training all staff on the new adaptations but also educating the public. She established the "Tech Wednesdays" program in which staff would safely teach seniors how to use zoom, create an email account, and other basic technological skills. With this help, we were able to teach over 30 seniors how to join us through their cell phone or computer and remain active from the safety of their home. The Las Palmas Golden Fun League was developed and offered Bingo, loteria, trivia games, Zumba classes via Zoom and Facebook Live. Mental health was also a big part of our programming- at least one mental health workshop was held every week during 2021.



With over 400 active older adults on file, Marisol learned that not all had access to technology so she had to communicate with them the old fashioned way- through the mail. Every month, Marisol would create a newsletter recapping previous events and promoting future ones. She would also create a monthly calendar showing all of the events for the month in addition to including a crossword puzzle which older adults could mail back to qualify for a raffle.



Marisol has demonstrated her ability to quickly adapt and keep older adults active and involved. During Park and Recreation Month, we want to recognize Marisol and her part time staff; Daisy Corona, Jenniffer Moreno, and Laura Almanza for all of their hard work in keeping our older adults active during this past year.



HOW TO MAKE A PAPER HAT (5-8)

Supplies: colored paper, ruler, pencil, scissors, glue or tape, markers

DIY RECYCLED SUSPENSION BRIDGE (6-8)*

Supplies: empty cereal box, 4 toilet paper tubes (or 2 paper towel tubes), blue & green painter's tape, string, small rubber bands, hole punch, scissors

DIY CRACKED MARBLE NAIL POLISH JEWELRY STONES (10-13)*

Supplies: various colors of nail polish, clear glass stones, pie plate, oven, jewelry backings (adult help required)
