PUBLIC STATEMENTS – WRITTEN/ORAL

Dr. Elizabeth Beltran, LAUSD Community Schools Administrator, provided a presentation to update the public on the new protocols implemented by the school district. Information was discussed at a recent Town Hall meeting. All information and updates are available on the website, social media and news letters.

Board Member Kelly Gonez discussed the measures schools are taking to keep students and the community safe due to the recent Omicron Variant. Mitigating the spread of Covid remains a priority. Information on testing and vaccination sites is available by contacting the LAUSD Board. Ms. Gonez also discussed the selection of the new Superintendent, Alberto Carvalho. Other updates included the BD6 Parent Advisory Cabinet focusing on ways to support English learners with sessions offered in Spanish and an upcoming art contest for students.

3) DISCUSSION REGARDING THE 2021-2022 STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM AND RELATED MATTERS

Chair Zobel-Rodriguez provided an update on the number of application submissions received for the 2021-2022 Scholarship Program. The deadline to submit applications is February 18, 2022. Vice Chair Govea will forward the scholarship forms to staff.

Commissioners Mohr requested that the City website display the Scholarship Program information on the homepage to continue promoting the program. Chair Zobel-Rodriguez volunteered to be the point person to answer incoming questions from the public when staff is unable to provide the requested information.

The Commission discussed the current budget for each scholarship. Commissioner Llamas suggested reviewing funds earlier in the season for the next scholarship cycle. Discussion ensued regarding edits to the donation letter such as adding a line to instruct donors to make checks payable to the City of San Fernando and the layout of the letter. Commissioner Mohr commented on the tree planting event hosted by Tree People. Several students participated and really enjoyed the event.

Commissioner Llamas thanked Chair Zobel-Rodriguez, Commissioner Mohr and the City for working on the Transportation grant to provide the community better and safer transportation access. San Fernando Middle School has been identified as a location that needs improved safety which is great news.

Vice Chair Govea thanked all educators for their continued work to ensure the safety for all students.

Chair Zobel-Rodriguez offered to speak to the TBC group to encourage students to apply for the scholarship program.

STAFF COMMUNICATION

The City was awarded a \$4.2 million grant through Prop. 68 to renovate Las Palmas Park. Staff will be inviting community input in the coming months.

RECOMMENDATION:

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS:

The San Fernando Education Commission (Commission) was established on May 5, 2011, and acts as the liaison between City and local schools administrations, the City's local board administrators for the Los Angeles Unified School District, and other public and private schools that operate in the city. The Annual Student Scholarship Essay Program was established to assist San Fernando youths who are seeking a postsecondary education.

RCS staff vetted 72 essays that were submitted during this 2021-2022 funding cycle. A breakdown of the eligible essays presented to the Education Commission for their reviewed per scholarship are listed below:

The Education Commission will discuss the essays and select the scholarship recipients for each of the scholarships. The awards amounts are based on the available fund balance per scholarship category. The Scholarships Donors and Accounts (Attachment "A") provides a breakdown of the available funds of each scholarship.

Staff will begin planning the awards reception upon the Education Commission's selection of date, time and location. The reception is expected to be an in-person event now that the Los Angeles County Department of Health (LACDPH) have eased the Covid-19 public gathering guidelines have been eased. However, an outside event will be considered if the Covid-19 infectious rate shoots up and stricter guidelines are implemented by LACDH.

BUDGET IMPACT:

The general scholarship account balance (053-2951) will be lowered by the award amounts the Education Commissions' recommendations.
