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GANN APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT

The Gann Spending Limitation (Article XIII B of the State Constitution) sets limits on the amount of tax revenues that the State and most local governments can appropriate within a given fiscal year. Fiscal Year 1978-1979 appropriations serve as the base for this limit and approved on November 6, 1979, by California voters. Under the Gann Limit, a maximum amount established for tax-funded government services. That amount adjusts each year depending on changes in state population, inflation and the transfer of financial responsibility for various government activities from one level of government to another. Any significant amount of state tax revenue received above that Gann Limit is to lead to future tax rebates or tax cuts.
