

1-5 NORTH COUNTY ENHANCEMENTS PROJECT

Overhead Sign Replacement

Summary

As part of the I-5 North County Enhancements Project, Metro's contractor OHLA-USA, will be replacing overhead signage throughout the project corridor. This activity requires replacing existing signage with temporary signs, followed by installing permanent signage when construction is complete. OHLA-USA will start to remove overhead signs, and install temporary signs, at multiple locations this year:

- Southbound I-5 between Hasley Canyon Rd and Newhall Ranch Rd
- Southbound I-5 between Newhall Ranch Rd and Rye Canyon Rd
- Southbound I-5 between Weldon Canyon Rd and SR-14

Upcoming Work/What to Expect

Removal of an existing overhead sign on southbound I-5 at Newhall Ranch Rd on **Tuesday, October 25, 2022,** between **10pm and 4am**, and **Wednesday, October 26, 2022,** between **10pm-4am, if needed**. Closures and detours:

- Full closure of southbound I-5 between Hasley Canyon Rd and SR-126.
 - **Detour 1:** Exit southbound I-5 at Hasley Canyon Rd/The Old Road, continue southbound on The Old Road, enter the southbound I-5 Rye Canyon Rd on-ramp.
 - **Detour 2:** Exit southbound I-5 at Hasley Canyon Rd/The Old Road, continue to Commerce Center Dr, enter eastbound SR-126, continue on SR-126 to the southbound I-5.
- Southbound I-5 lane closures between Parker Rd and SR-126 from 8pm to 6am.

Essential Details

- Work schedule: Tuesday, October 25, 2022, between 10pm and 4am, and Wednesday, October 26, 2022, between 10pm-4am if needed.
- Consecutive ramps in the same direction will not be closed at the same time. Detours to the next on-ramp will be posted for each closure.
- No lane closures will be implemented during morning or evening peak traffic hours.
- The speed limit within construction work zones is changed to 55-miles per hour.

Noteworthy

Access to emergency responders will be maintained. Construction is a dynamic process, it is subject to weather conditions, and information is subject to change, visit the project website for the most up to date information and a weekly listing of ramp closures scheduled.
