CITY OF SAN FERNANDO TO HOST THIRD ANNUAL PRIDE FLAG RAISING CEREMONY TO MARK PRIDE MONTH

SAN FERNANDO, CA – In June 2021, the San Fernando City Council adopted a Resolution declaring June as “Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender and Queer Pride Month (LGBTQ+) in the City of San Fernando and call[ed] upon all residents to eliminate prejudice everywhere it exists, and to celebrate the great diversity of our city.”

To commemorate this historic Resolution, the City will be hosting the Third Annual Progressive Pride Flag Raising Ceremony on the steps of San Fernando City Hall on Thursday, June 1, 2023, at 9 a.m. Mayor Celeste Rodriguez will join other City Councilmembers, local dignitaries, and LGBTQ+ representatives to mark the start of Pride Month and raise the Progressive Pride Flag at City Hall.

Progressive Pride Flags will be flown at all City facilities and in the Downtown Mall throughout the month of June 2023 to support Pride Month.

Raising the Progressive Pride Flag at City Hall is meant to increase awareness, acceptance, and inclusion of Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender and Queer individuals. The public is invited to attend the ceremony and show their support.
