ARMED ROBBERY AT CHASE BANK - 402 S. BRAND BLVD.

SAN FERNANDO, CA – On Tuesday, October 31, 2023, at about 10:15 am, San Fernando Police responded to multiple 911 calls regarding a possible armed robbery in progress at Chase Bank, located at 402 S. Brand Blvd in San Fernando. Officers arrived on scene and received additional information that the suspect was still in the bank. Officers entered the bank and determined the suspect had fled the location prior to their arrival. There were no reported injuries during the incident. Bank officials are working on establishing how much money was taken during the robbery.



It appears that the suspect may have also committed another robbery in the San Fernando Valley earlier the same morning. The suspect is described as a male, Hispanic or African-American, about 6 feet tall, driving a white 4 door sedan, possibly a Ford Fusion. San Fernando Police Detectives are currently working with the Los Angeles Police

Department and the FBI to identify and apprehend the suspect.
