



DAY CAMP COUNSELOR THE POSITION

The City of San Fernando is seeking experienced and responsible professional to become a Day Camp Counselor in our Recreation and Community Services Department.

Under direction of the Program Specialist or Senior Day Camp Counselor, to monitor and supervise the activities of children in a day camp setting; will be responsible for about 10 to 15 children daily, and perform other related duties as required.

IMPORTANT AND ESSENTIAL DUTIES

- Leads, directs, and supervises children, ages six to 12, in games, activities, excursions, and other outdoor activities.
- Observes and monitors children in camp, and responds to unsafe acts or conditions.
- May administer First Aid.
- Adheres to City and departmental policies and procedures.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.

JOB-RELATED AND ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS

Knowledge Of:

Methods and practices used in maintaining an effective day camp program and program promotion and advertising.

Ability To:

Establish and maintain effective working relationships with the children, the general public, and staff. Apply CPR and First Aid. Understand and follow written and oral instructions.

EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING GUIDELINES

A typical way of obtaining the knowledge, skills and abilities would be the following:

Experience:

One year of experience in working with children ages six to 12 years old, in a day camp setting, an organized recreational program, or related activity.

Training:

High School graduation or GED equivalent is required.

Special Requirements:

Must possess a valid California Class C driver's license along with car insurance on appointment and as a condition of continued employment. Must have own transportation to travel within City limits. Must be at least 18 years of age.

Work Schedule:

Part-time, 18 to 20 hours per week. Flexible schedule; may be required to work weekends.

EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING GUIDELINES (Continued)

Desirable Requirements:

Ability to understand and speak Spanish. Certification in First Aid and CPR.

Physical Abilities & Environmental Conditions:

Ability to sit, kneel, stand, walk, crouch, stoop, reach, twist, climb, and lift 50 lbs; may be exposed to the sun, and work under high and low temperatures (mostly between 40 and 90 degrees); and may be exposed to frequent loud noises and toxic/poisonous substance, as well as, slippery surfaces.

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COMPENSATION & BENEFITS

Hourly Salary: \$16.00 - \$18.91

NOTE: This is an at-will, part-time position with minimal benefits.

BILINGUAL BONUS \$50 per month upon passing Bilingual exam.

TUITION REIMBURSEMENT Up to \$1,500 per fiscal year for approved courses.

ABOUT THE CITY

Only 23 miles north of downtown Los Angeles, the City of San Fernando is nestled at the foothills of the San Gabriel Mountains in the San Fernando Valley. Incorporated in 1911, San Fernando has a population of approximately 25,000, and is a diverse, family-oriented community of about 2.4 square miles. The City contracts for fire services with the City of Los Angeles.
