Subject: Phase 3 Annual Street Resurfacing Project Construction Management Services

- 1. Is there a page limit for the proposal? Answer: There is no page limit for the proposal.
- 2. Do you have a list of RFP holders by chance? No *Answer: No, a list is not available at this time.*
- 3. Do you have an estimate of the added working days should the optional scope be added? Answer: An additional 30 days will be added for the optional scope.
- 4. For quality assurance, what tests is the City looking for? Compaction, concrete, asphalt testing, batch plant, micro-surface, ARAM, slurry seal? All per the Greenbook? *Answer: The tests shall include testing of compaction and all asphalt material including microsurfacing, ARAM and slurry seal.*
- 5. What type of funds are being used for this project? Is there any CDBG where labor compliance will need to be tailored for section 3 requirements? Answer: The funding sources are SB1, Proposition C, Measure R and State Gas tax. No CDBG funding was allocated for this project.
- 6. Is there any potential geofabric on the streets? The dig-out removals discuss macadam, but not geofabric, which is also an added cost when dumping. (Glenoaks in SF had geofabric when I worked on it).

Answer: To our knowledge, there is no geofabric on the streets being worked on.

7. The traffic control is per MUTCD on bid item 1, but page T-1 of the project specs says the contractor shall submit a traffic control plan. Just confirming if that will be a submittal we will be managing or not.

Answer: The traffic control plan shall be based per MUTCD requirements.

- 8. Can you please provide the anticipated start date for the project? Answer: The project is expected to commence around April 8, 2024.
- 9. Do you have an engineer's estimate? If so, can you provide it? Answer: The Engineer's Estimate for this project is as follows: Base Bid Amount is \$1,244,463.33; Additional Scope: \$738,173.25.
