1) Update regarding the Sixth Cycle Regional Housing Needs Assessment (RHNA) Draft Allocation

STAFF PRESENTATION

T. Hou provided the Commission with the chronological timeline on the allocation of Housing Units identified by RHNA and the Appeal procedure.

COMMISSION DISCUSSION

The commission asked if the Light Rail was taken into consideration and if Accessory Dwelling Units were considered new housing units. The Commission also expressed concern that the required housing units are an unrealistic number considering the size of our city.

T. Hou stated that one of the main variables was the proximity of high quality transit and that increases the number of housing units required in that City. He also explained that not just Accessory Dwelling Unit count but also Junior Accessory Dwelling Units which can create three units on each lot which can help us achieve the number of housing units required.
