SPECIAL INTEREST

CASA DE LOPEZ ADOBE

The two-story Monterey-type adobe home was completed in 1883 by Valentin Lopez as a gift for his sister Catalina and her husband Geronimo Lopez. The family lived in the area long before the City of San Fernando was conceived and became known as the town's "first family." Members of the Lopez family lived in the adobe until 1962. The home was purchased from the Lopez family in 1970 and restored in 1974 as the original building for use as an early historical site, opening its doors to the public on April 5, 1975.
