RESPONSE TO QUESTIONS

SEPTEMBER 30, 2024

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- QUESTION:** Does the SFPD currently use or intend to use products from Cisco-Meraki or Verkada in their infrastructure?

ANSWER: The City does not plan to use Cisco-Meraki or Verkada products in the infrastructure due to their proprietary nature. Instead, the City prefers to implement systems and products that are compatible with multiple platforms, such as Avigilon.
- QUESTION:** Please describe in more detail the expected "compatibility with existing Axon Body Worn Camera systems for seamless evidence sharing." and what this should entail. This project is focused on the physical department facility and not mobile or crime focused locations, we need to clarify the expectations for integration of platforms, and propose if possible a solution.

ANSWER: If any footage is required for criminal investigations, the Department must be able to upload the footage to Evidence.com. Axon/Evidence.com only accepts the following file formats: .3gp, .3gpp, .3g2, .asf, .avi, .divx, .f4v, .flv, .mkv, .mov, .mpeg, .mpg, .mp4, .m4v, .qt, .ram, .rm, .ts, .tts, .vob, .webm, and .wmv. Proposed systems must support seamless and straightforward export to these accepted file formats.
- QUESTION:** Will the construction or installation work performed need to be prevailing wage?

ANSWER: Yes, prevailing wages are required for work performed.
- QUESTION:** Is there a specific allocation of funds to this project that cannot be exceeded?

ANSWER: Yes. This project is funded by Urban Area Security Initiative grant funds through FEMA. The budgeted amount is \$135,504.
- QUESTION:** There will be a monthly or annual fee per device for cloud storage and dashboard, with most manufacturers' contracts to be multiyear, will this be part of the proposal, and if so is there a preference for 3 or 5 years?

ANSWER: The proposed term of the contract is three years, with options for two one-year extensions at the City's discretion.
- QUESTION:** Can we itemize the proposal or present multiple solutions to fit different budgets and products?
