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OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY AWARDS \$44,400 GRANT TO THE SAN FERNANDO POLICE DEPARTMENT TO IMPROVE TRAFFIC DATA REPORTING

SAN FERNANDO, CA – The San Fernando Police Department announced today that it has received a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) for a traffic records improvement project to report crash and citation data faster and more efficiently. The grant program runs through September 2025.
