The City proudly announces the launch of the Small Business Assistance Program (SBAP), a new initiative designed to help local businesses. This program offers grant funding of up to \$10,000 to support the vibrant small business community in the City.

USE OF GRANT FUNDS

- Anti-graffiti coating and graffiti-resistant window covering
- Exterior vertical landscape (green wall)
- Signage (up to \$3,000)
- Paint
- Awning or window shade cover
- Exterior security cameras with direct access granted to SFPD
- Exterior architectural details

ELIGIBLE BUSINESSES

- Restaurants, coffee shops, bakeries, etc.
- Salons, barbers, and other grooming businesses
- Gyms, day spas, and fitness studios
- Retail and commercial stores
- Others not on the ineligible list

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Located in a commercial or mixed-use property
- Priority to businesses with high incidence of graffiti
- Operating for a minimum of three years, or have a minimum of a two-year lease or mortgage
- Has an active business license
- Employs 50 or fewer individuals
- Current on water and trash bill payments
