

NOTICE OF A PUBLIC HEARING

OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN FERNANDO, CALIFORNIA TO CONSIDER ADOPTING AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 90 (TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES) OF THE SAN FERNANDO MUNICIPAL CODE TO IMPLEMENT A RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMIT PROGRAM AND TO MODIFY PARKING RESTRICTIONS OF CAMPERS, RECREATIONAL VEHICLES, UTILITY TRAILERS AND OTHER VEHICLES INCLUDING THOSE USED FOR HUMAN HABITATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of San Fernando will hold a public hearing to consider adopting an ordinance amending the Chapter 900 (Traffic and Vehicles) of the City of San Fernando's Municipal Code (SFMC).

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: City-Initiated Municipal Code Amendment, amending Chapter 90 (Traffic and Vehicles) of the City of San Fernando's Municipal Code (SFMC) to implement a residential parking permit program and to modify parking restrictions of campers, recreational vehicles, utility trailers and other vehicles including those used for human habitation.

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW: Pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of the Guidelines for the Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") of 1970, as amended, the lead agency has determined that the proposed activity is exempt from CEQA. The City as the lead agency has determined with certainty that the proposed activity will not have a significant effect on the environment as the prosed amendments are intended to address parking of vehicles.
