## SAN FERNANDO CITY MANAGER NICK KIMBALL ANNOUNCES RESIGNATION AFTER NEARLY 11 YEARS OF SERVICE

**SAN FERNANDO, CA** – After nearly 11 years of dedicated service to the San Fernando community, City Manager Nick Kimball has announced his resignation, effective July 4, 2025, to accept the position of Assistant City Manager/Chief Financial Officer with the City of South Pasadena. To ensure continuity in the City's leadership on key priorities, the City Council has appointed Deputy City Manager Kanika Kith to serve as Interim City Manager upon Kimball's departure.

Nick Kimball joined the City of San Fernando in July 2014 as Director of Finance and, after holding a number of executive management positions, including Interim City Manager, was appointed as permanent City Manager in January 2019. Under his leadership, the City achieved numerous milestones, including stabilizing City finances, launching key infrastructure improvements, expanding community programs, and strengthening regional partnerships.

"It has been an incredible honor to serve the San Fernando community and to work alongside such dedicated and passionate City staff," said Kimball. "I'm proud of what we've accomplished together over the past decade and confident that the City is well-positioned for continued success."

"The City Council expresses its deep appreciation to Nick for his years of dedicated service and exemplary leadership," said Mayor Mary Mendoza. "His steadfast commitment to transparency, fiscal responsibility, and meaningful community engagement has left a lasting and positive impact on San Fernando.
