**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City Council of the City of San Fernando will hold a public hearing to consider adopting an ordinance amending Section 90-220 (Parking of trailers semitrailer, camp trailers and recreational trailers) of Division 1 (Generally) of Article IV (Stopping, Standing and Parking) of Chapter 90 (Traffic and Vehicles) of the San Fernando Municipal Code is hereby retitled and amended in its entirety.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** City-Initiated Municipal Code Amendment, amending Section 90-220 (Parking of trailers semitrailer, camp trailers and recreational trailers) of Division 1 (Generally) of Article IV (Stopping, Standing and Parking) of Chapter 90 (Traffic and Vehicles) of the San Fernando Municipal Code is hereby retitled and amended in its entirety.
